Satan's Plan
– makes you question God's Word and his goodness ( <b>Gen. 3:1</b> )
– Makes you look at your problems rather than at God (Elijah - 1 Kings 18)
– Makes the wrong things seem attractive so that you will want them
more than the right things ( <b>Prov. 14:12</b> )
– Makes you feel like a failure so that you don't even try ( <b>Peter – John 21:3</b> )
– Makes you put off doing something that it never or takes a while to get done
(Jonah)

• Ephesians 4:26 – It helps us not to act out of our emotions
• Ephesians 4:27 – It helps us not to be submissive to our flesh, the world, and Satan
